

"What is it?" I hear you ask!

It was started by self-proclaimed 'money dame' parishioner Joan Hines, as a means to raise funds to repair the church spires in the 1970s (sound familiar??!). Since then it has raised on average \$4-5,000 for the parish each year.

How does it work?

It costs \$5 a week for twenty weeks before a major prize draw is held in June (first prize being \$1,000).....And then it starts all over again in July!
