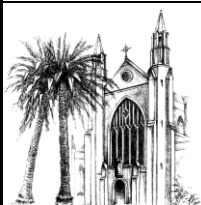

GRASS ROOTS DIALOGUE PROJECT



Since its establishment 30 years ago the Victorian Council of Christians and Jews (CCJ) has been at the forefront of interfaith dialogue in Melbourne. The Grass Roots Dialogue Project is the latest program initiated by the CCJ to promote engagement between Christians and Jews. We hope the project will contribute towards the ongoing work of creating a spirit of respect between religious traditions.

This morning the Grass Roots Dialogue Project will be visiting Holy Rosary Parish for the 9.00am Mass. The presenters will be Sue Mendelson from the Jewish tradition and Nick Mattiske from the Lutheran tradition. They will speak during the 9.00am Mass about this important initiative. After the 9.00am Mass there will be a cuppa and our guests will make themselves available for a 'question and answer' session. Dear Parishioners of St Brendan's & Holy Rosary,

It is with much sadness that I advise that I am being transferred from St Brendan's & Holy Rosary. I have been asked to fill a full-time teaching position at Catholic Theological College, East Melbourne (CTC) due to the impending retirement of a senior lecturer.

The Archbishop called me into his office last week to discuss the matter. He wants me in place at CTC by the end of July. This is because I am to accompany the CTC Overseas Study Tour in September and to prepare new study units for 2016.

I will no longer be a parish priest but will be sent to a parish as 'priest-in-residence'. This parish has not yet been determined. Things moved very fast during the week and admit I that I was feeling a little overwhelmed and had a few sleepless nights!! Such times of transition are always very difficult moments. I hope we can support each other and pray for each other and our communities at this time.

As I celebrated the weekend Masses for Pentecost, I was conscious of St Paul's words in the second reading - 'What the Spirit brings is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness and gentleness'. May the Spirit guide us all in the weeks ahead and in the choice of a new parish priest for St Brendan's and Holy Rosary.
