SABBATICAL – FR MAX VODOLA

I wish to inform parishioners that I will be away on sabbatical leave from Monday 1 September until Monday 1 December.

The Archbishop has granted me study leave overseas in order to publish my thesis on Pope John XXIII and Vatican II and attend some conferences. I will be in Rome, Bologna, Bergamo, visit Ireland for the first time and return home via the United States for a conference of the American Academy of Religion.

During this time, Fr Francis and the parish staff will keep things going as usual on weekdays. During the month of September, Salesian priests Fr Bernie Graham and Fr Peter Varengo will assist with Masses. In October and November, Fr George O'Connor, a retired priest has generously offered to assist. Please make them welcome and thanks to all for your cooperation and assistance.
