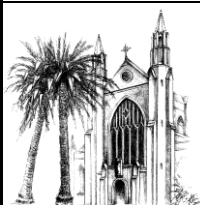

BRENDAN'S.....SNAPSHOTS OF HISTORY</p> <p><i>Last Sunday, His Grace, Archbishop Carr the Archbishop of Melbourne visited St Brendan's, Flemington for the purpose of administering the Sacrament of Confirmation. There were 180 candidates confirmed.
