SNAPSHOT IN HISTORY

St. Brendan of Clonfert known also as Brendan the Voyager was born in County Kerry, Ireland in 484 AD and died at aged 93 years.

His Feast Day is celebrated on the 16th May.

St. Brendan was ordained as a Priest in 512 AD.

He is remembered for his famous voyage sailing with his fellow monks in his leather boat to North West Europe, spreading the Christian faith, founding monasteries and reaching the "Land of Paradise".
