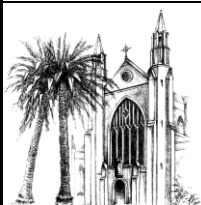

SNAPSHOT IN HISTORY

The beautiful stained glass windows in St Brendan's Church were commissioned in 1948 by Fr Patrick Lynch. They were erected as memorials to former Parish Priests, Fr. M. Carroll, Fr. J Gleeson and Fr W. O'Dwyer. The windows depict the Patron Saints of Australia, St. Francis Xavier, St Theresa of Lisieux and Our Lady Help of Christians and our own Patron, St Brendan. The smaller window located on the side door leading to the Presbytery features St Brendan with his fellow monks in his leather boat with the celtic cross on the mast.
