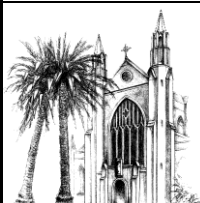

JIBRANG SCHOOL, NEPAL

Good Evening Father Hien,

The trip to Nepal was amazing. We flew in to the capital city, Kathmandu & then flew on a small plane to a small town called Pokhara and this is where our adventure began.

Our group of 16 students and 2 teachers (the other group of 18 followed a few days behind us) set out on the famous Annapurna trail for several days trekking to the highest point of our trip, Poon Hill which at over 3700 metres is considerably higher than Australia's largest mountain, Kosciuszko. Poon Hill provided magnificent & uninterrupted views across the whole of the Annapurna range before we trekked down to the remote village of Jilbrang in the foothills of the Annapurna.

The school here currently houses 140 students from the surrounding area aged between 3 & 14 years. The school is in need of renovations and we worked on building a fence around the perimeter of the school. The money raised from our fundraising will go towards the works undertaken in this year and during the 2018 tour.

I learnt so much on this trip and I feel very privileged to have been able to be a part of the 2017 adventure.

The people of Jilbrang live a simple life and they don't have anything like the facilities and services that we take for granted. However, they are very kind, gentle people who seemed to have a positive energy about them and appeared to live happy lives.

I want to say thank you to everyone at Holy Rosary & St Brendan's for their kind words of support & generosity in giving to the community project. I know that the people of Jilbrang really appreciate the work that we have done and the financial support.
