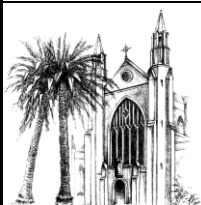

**Journey through Lent to Easter** - Forty days of preparation until we share in the great day of the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Let us walk this path in reflection.

*Bless us on our journey through the desert of Lent to the font of rebirth*

By the solemn forty days of Lent the Church unites itself each year to the mystery of Jesus in the desert. The desert experience of Jesus is the basis of Lent. The Gospels recount his self denial, his temptations, his triumph over Satan We are called at this time to enter into the experience of Christ, by practising self-denial and resisting temptation.

The expression 'forty days & forty nights' is significant in biblical writing. It means a 'very long time'. Jesus' 40 day fast in the desert is a reminder of the Israelites 40 years in the wilderness

Through the sharing of the ashes and the entering into the season of Lent we are like the Israelites, like Jesus, preparing and being prepared for the journey to Jerusalem
