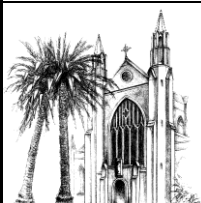

A native family from Bethlehem - the Holy Land, will be setting up an **olive wood display in the church foyer** in the weekend of **28/29 October** for the vigil Saturday Mass as well as the Sunday morning Mass at St . Brendan's and Holy Rosary. The display consists of religious artefacts such as rosaries , crosses , nativity scene and Christmas ornaments hand made by the Christian family in Bethlehem . The proceeds of the sale will help these families who decided to stay, despite the ongoing political struggle, to remain in the Holy land and preserve the Christian existence and support them financially when the number of pilgrims dropped down in the late years due to the Middle East conflict.
