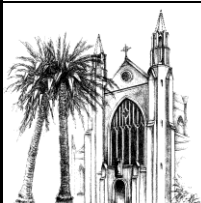

SNAPSHOT IN HISTORY

Some of the first Sisters of Mercy to be responsible for both the Teachers College and St Brendan's School, between 1909 and 1939, had previously been involved in a small Teachers College (called St. Aloysius Teachers College) based at Sacred Heart College Geelong. These include Mother Evangelist Doogan, Mother Patricia O'Neill, Sister M. Gonzaga McChoppin, and Sister M. Pauline Murphy. Much loved members of the staff in later years include Sister M. Vivian Dwyer, (Principal of St Brendan's and the Teachers College), Sister Monica Taylor (Infant School) and Sister Yolanda Bongiorno (Kindergarten). There were some long serving lay teacher also, Mrs Begley and Mrs Pitney.
