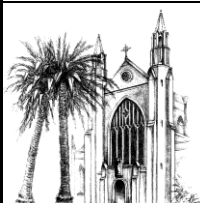

#### SNAPSHOT IN HISTORY

St. Brendan's, Flemington School was established in 1887 and consisted of 1 room next to the original Church where the Parish Hall now stands in Church Street.

The first Head Master was James Nally. Catholic parishioners raised funds to provide a basic salary for the teacher and a living allowance for the Pupil Teachers in-training.
