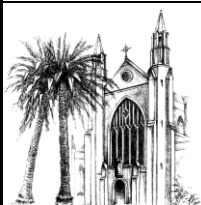

'24 HOURS FOR THE LORD': ST PATRICK'S CATHEDRAL

This Lent, Pope Francis invites dioceses, parishes and communities around the world to join him in participating in a time of prayer and reconciliation with the Lord. This time of prayer and conversion is especially poignant in this Jubilee Year of Mercy. With this in mind, we invite you to a Year of Mercy '24 hours for the Lord' event at St Patrick's Cathedral. It will begin on Friday 4 March from 6am to 11pm and continue on Saturday 5 March from 6am to 11am. This event is one of many that are happening around the diocese and serves as a model that parishes might adopt for their own use. The two-day program includes Mass, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Benediction, Prayers of the Church, Lectio Divina, the Rosary, and other forms of prayer led by various groups in the archdiocese. The program will include prayer intentions for refugees, the sick and elderly, and for peace in the Middle East. Priests will also be available throughout the 24 hours for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The Mercy Door at St Patrick's Cathedral will also be open throughout this prayer time.
