Next Sunday, 7 September, is Father's Day and there will be a special collection for the sick and retired priests of the Archdiocese of Melbourne. The theme of the appeal is 'caring for those who cared', honouring those who have given their lives in faithful priestly service over many years. **There are currently 90 retired priests in the Archdiocese and it costs almost 3 million dollars per year to care for them.** There will be more retirements in the future and these costs will increase.

Priests do not have a superannuation scheme. It is this collection (and the aged pension that some are able to receive) that enable them to have an appropriate and dignified retirement. Some priests live independently, others need a combination of low-care and high-care nursing facilities.
