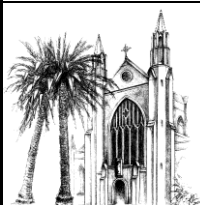

Dear Friends,

The National Liturgical Music Board has published a new Hymn Book for use in parishes. It is dedicated to the memory of **Rev. DR William Anthony Jordan** whom you know as Fr Bill Jordan who was here with us for 26 years.

The new hymn book (**Catholic Worship Book II**) is approved and endorsed by the Australian Catholic Bishops Conference. It is the official liturgical music resource for the Catholic Church in Australia. It is a valuable aid to our worship and the celebration of the church's liturgical year.

Our Diocese and a few parishes are already using the new Hymn Book and they are finding its enriching for their music ministry. I wish to adopt it for our community. The cost is \$39 each book. If we can cover this cost by family donation it would be greatly appreciated. However, smaller donations would also be acceptable. We hope to have it in use by this Easter Celebration.

In acknowledgement of Fr Bill and your generous contribution we will place in each book a label recognising your generosity. For example (**This Hymn Book was donated by Smith Family in memory of Fr Bill Jordan**).

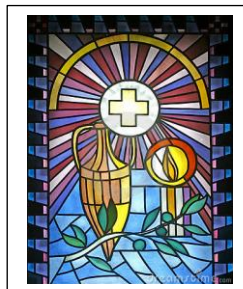
