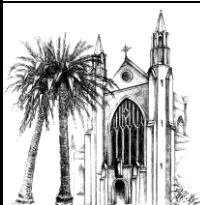

Jesuit College of Spirituality is pleased to announce this lecture by Dr Andrew Pinsent. What does science have to say about spirituality? Over 750 years ago St Thomas Aquinas offered an account of the way that the Gifts of the Holy Spirit form (or should help form) the character of anyone living a Christian life. In this talk, Dr Andrew Pinsent from the University of Oxford offers an interpretation of Aquinas's work based on recent research from psychology and neuroscience. These insights are not only theoretical but should help enrich anyone trying to live a Christian life in the modern world. Dr Pinsent is an international speaker, in great demand across the globe.
