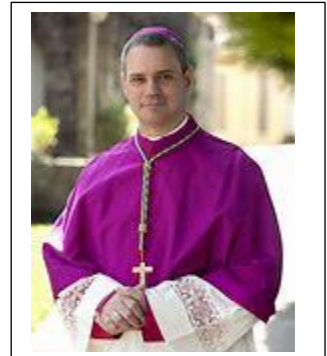
Archbishops Catholic Man Breakfast Series

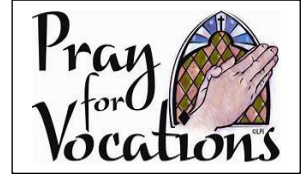
