Reflection:

Pope Francis' first action after being elected was to remain on the ground floor with everyone else, rather than climb the steps to the throne from which past popes received the pledges of the cardinals. His first words to the faithful were a call for them to pray for him. Pope Francis has focused his attention on the poor. He doesn't live in the papal apartments but rather in the Casa Santa Marta residence inside the Vatican, where he eats dinner in the company of lower-ranking priests and visitors. Today's Gospel contrasts a proud Pharisee and a humble tax collector as they come to pray in the temple. Jesus uses that story to teach us that the ones who exalt themselves will be humbled, and the ones who humble themselves will be exalted.
